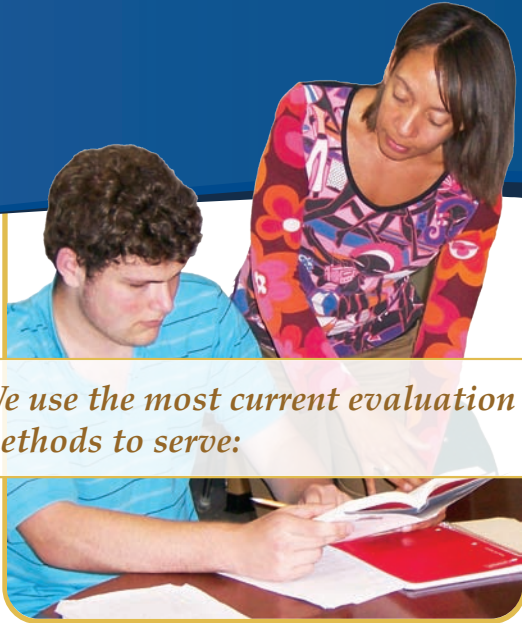

### *Our assessment process:*

- Complete a preliminary assessment over the phone to determine the appropriate path and assessment procedure
- The assessment requires 2-12 hours of direct time with a licensed psychologist or neuropsychologist
- Testing completed at The Pathway School or in the student's local school district
- Testing includes:
  - Review of developmental, medical, behavioral, educational and family history
  - Review of educational records and test scores, as well as results of other psychological assessments
  - Clinical interview
- Parents and/or school districts will receive a comprehensive written report as well as specific recommendations for education, transition, and career planning
- Schedule a feedback session with the psychologist to thoroughly discuss the child's strengths and needs, along with recommendations for accommodations and planning
